

TRADE JOURNEYMAN BRIDGE WORKER (TJB) – SERVICE AREA 14

Position

Under the supervision and direction of an immediate trade related Supervisor and/or Management staff from time to time, to carry out Journeyman duties involving functions related to the Bridge Worker trade.

Duties

- Perform skilled journeyman work within the scope of the trade in which qualifications apply
- Duties may include: reconstruction and/or construction of storage sheds, shelters, pipe arches, tunnels and retaining walls
- To operate related equipment and tools of the trade, including cranes and/or pile drivers
- Document all work related records and reports as required by VSA and/or the Ministry of Transportation
- Direct the work of one or two Bridge Workers/Laborers or non-trade related positions assigned to assist as required
- Assist apprentices in learning and developing the knowledge and skills of the trade
- Perform other trade related duties as required

Qualifications

- Preferably secondary school graduation
- Completion of apprenticeship vocational training for the Bridge Worker Trade

- Valid Certificate of Qualification issued by the B.C. Ministry of Labour or the approved equivalent for the Bridge Worker Trade
- Valid B.C. Drivers License Class 3 with Air Brake Endorsement; preferably Class 1
- Ability to read and interpret trade related information and Bridge Maintenance Specifications Standards
- Good knowledge of VSA's safety policies
- Good knowledge of VSA's QMS and ISO Manuals, as they pertain to the operation of vehicles, equipment and employees involved in Bridge Maintenance
- Good knowledge of safety rules and regulations of WorkSafe BC, W.H.M.I.S. and as they pertain to the operation of vehicles, equipment and employees involved in Bridge Maintenance

Skills and Abilities

- Physically fit, ability to work outside in any and all weather conditions.
- Ability to substitute to a Trade Supervisor position

Proviso

- Shift work may be required in accordance with the current collective agreement.
- Working under conditions consistent with the trade, high elevations, on or above deep and/or flowing water.
